

Some notes about the Dunvegan Village Hall

The Clan MacLeod Parliament has again rented the Dunvegan Village Hall, to be used as a center for Parliament operations and the venue for many of our functions. The revenue will help maintain and improve the facility for the community.

The Village Hall includes two large function rooms: on the ground floor is the **Norman Magnus Hall** (center of the original building) and the **Sports Hall**, part of a newer wing that includes the coffee bar, kitchen, and public rest rooms. On the upper floor there is a Game Room overlooking the Sports Hall, as well as the Dame Flora Lounge. Across the street from the Village Hall is a public parking lot and bus stop, with additional public rest rooms (and the Dunvegan recycling center).

Both banks have 24 hour ATM machines. In Dunvegan, cash withdrawals can be made from the Link ATM at Fasgadh (food store) or the Royal Bank of Scotland's mobile banking unit, which will be at Fasgadh's between about 13.30 – 14.30 on Tuesday and 12.00 – 13.00 on Thursday. <p>Taxis</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Dunvegan Taxis 01470 521560 (within the Village). <p>Internet</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> At the time this leaflet was written, we expected to have Internet access at the Village Hall. If this doesn't work out, the Clan Information Point will have a list of alternative sites. <p>Mobile phone top-ups</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Locations where mobile phone top-up cards can be purchased will also be posted at the Village Hall. Mobile phone top-ups (without cards) can also be done at the Royal Bank of Scotland in Portree.

During our time on Skye, an Information Point will be staffed by NRG at the Dunvegan Village Hall at the following times: during registration, and from 9AM until noon Monday 25 July through Saturday 05 August. You may also call the Information Point at +44 (0)777 450-5038 during these hours. All event reservations or cancellations must be made at Parliament registration or else through the Information Point. A lost and found will be maintained at the Information Point in the Village Hall. Articles left unclaimed after Saturday 05 August will be recycled or else donated to charity.
