Quiz Night

Teams will consist of four persons, representing at least two countries and to contain at least one member under the age of 40. Questions will be asked in rounds of 10 questions, on general knowledge, music, current events and Clan History. After each round, cards will be marked by the adjacent table. The team with the highest score will be declared the winner.

Midge Drive

Modeled after the classic British card game “Beetle Drive” (and respecting the fact that Parliament takes place in the land of the midge). Teams will roll dice and hope to be the first to get the magic sequence that allows you to draw your midge on a piece of paper. Suitable for young and old, and can involve a lot of cheering and jumping around.

The Dunvegan Code

An unnamed Albino Monk will host the Dunvegan Code. Teams of four will also compete in the Dunvegan Code, something of a scavenger hunt, something of a riddle. Teams will receive an initial clue and be off (on foot) in the Dunvegan Village. It should take about 1 ½ hours to complete, but don't be surprised if your clue brings you back to the Village Hall for an interim peek at the Silent Auction.
