**Some notes about the ferries:**

- It is probably easier to leave your car at Uig on your way to Stornoway. If you leave your car at Ullapool, it will take several hours to get back to Ullapool from Dunvegan using public transportation.
- Make ferry reservations for your car well in advance, and be at the ferry at the required times before departure. (There may be others wait-listed to take your space!)
- Foot passengers do not need ferry reservations, just purchase your ticket and be ready to walk on the ship at the required time before departure

**Internet**

- STORNOWAY: Caberfeidh Hotel has internet service in all guest rooms. Additional access available at Public Library. TARBERT: public rooms of Harris Hotel or else the Public Library (co-located with Secondary School).

**Mobile phone top-ups**

- In STORNOWAY or HARRIS: UK mobile phone top-up cards can be funded in most shops, Post Office, and gas stations.
- Mobile phones can also be topped off at the bank offices or ATMs mentioned above.

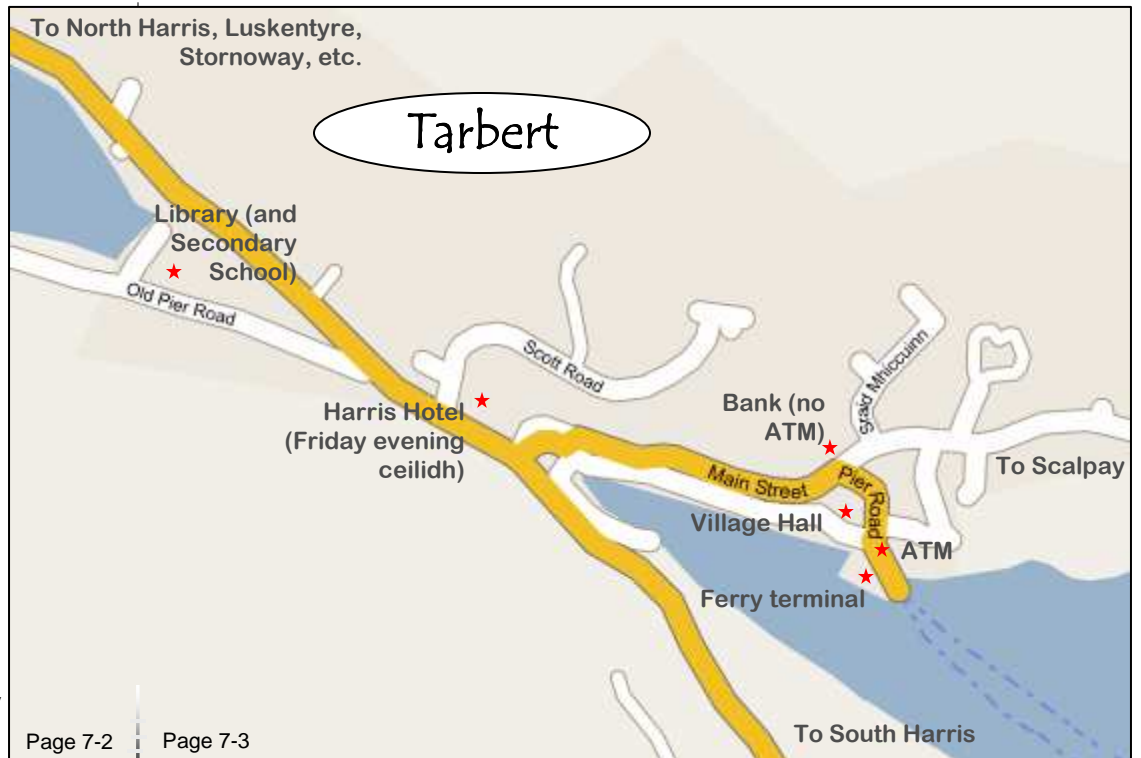
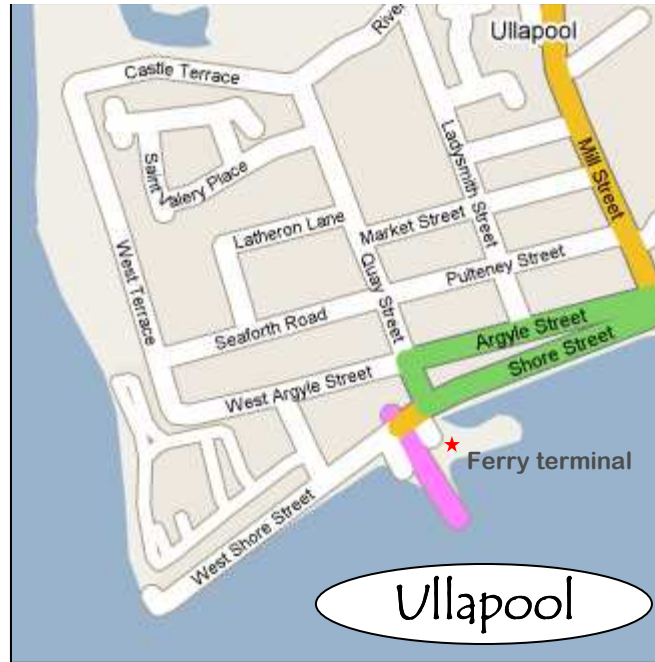
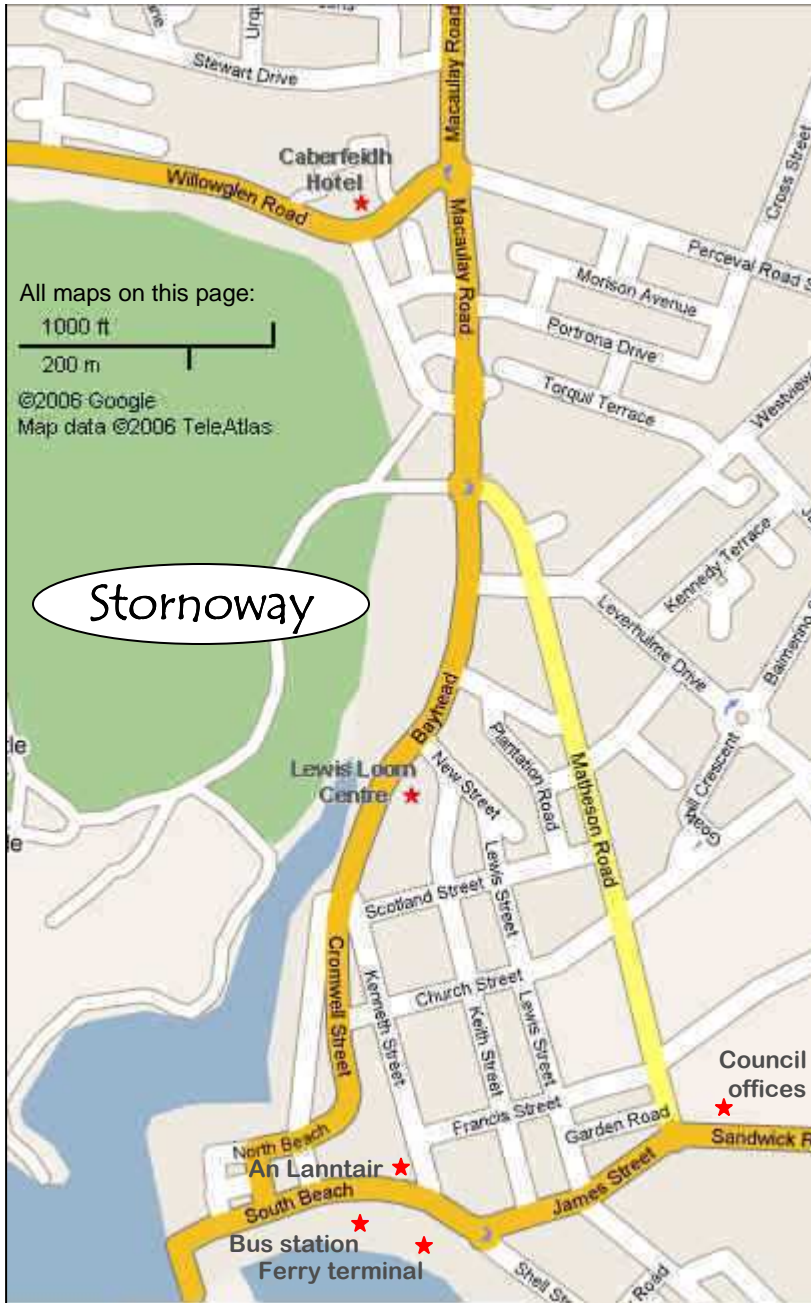
